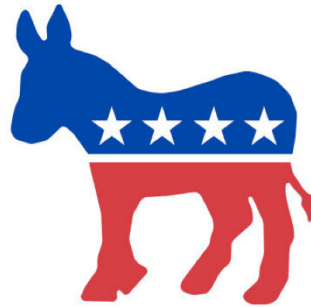

The DFL came into being in its modern form when the Minnesota Democratic and Farmer–Labor parties merged in April 1944.
