



Updates for Convenor Script

Governor Preference Ballot: As only one candidate reached out to the DFL Party Chair about participating in the Preference Ballot - per the DFL Official Call - we will not be conducting a preference ballot in 2022.

Change to Caucus Attendee Eligibility: Per the direction of the DFL State Central Committee the eligibility requirements have been updated to remove the requirement that a person be eligible to vote. Below is the new eligibility statement that should be read during the meeting.

When you signed in to caucus you agreed to the following four items: (1) You live in the precinct. (2) You consider yourself a member of DFL Party and agree with its principles as stated in the Preamble of the State DFL Constitution and Bylaws. (3) You are not an active member of any other political party. (4) You will be at least 18 years old by November 8, 2022 if you want to vote or run for any position elected at the caucus, including delegate or alternate, or precinct officer. Alternatively, to be eligible to participate in all other caucus business, you will be 16 years old by November 8, 2022.
