



Agent Delivery FAQ

Question	Answer
Who qualifies for Agent Delivery?	<p>To qualify for agent delivery, you must live in a:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nursing home - Assisted living facility - Residential treatment center - Group home - Battered women's shelter <p>Or:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be hospitalized - Unable to go to the polling place due to incapacitating health reasons or a medical condition.
How are ballots picked up and returned?	<p>You must complete a request for an <u>agent delivery of absentee ballot</u> form. Give that form and your absentee ballot application to your agent. Have your agent take both forms to the local election office to receive your ballot.</p> <p>Your agent can pick up your ballot starting seven days before the election until 2 p.m. on Election Day. For the 2022 General Election, your agent can pick up the ballot starting on November 1st until November 8th at 2 p.m.</p> <p>Your agent or someone else you designate must return your ballot to the same elections office by 3 p.m. on Election Day (November 8th, 2022). You can also return your ballot by mail. Election officials must receive your ballot on or before Election Day.</p>
Who can be an agent?	<p>Your agent must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be at least 18 years old - Have a pre-existing relationship with you <p>Your agent cannot:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be a candidate - Be an agent of more than three voters in an election
