Know Your Rights

AS A MINNESOTA VOTER, YOU HAVE MANY RIGHTS - GET TO KNOW THEM!

- **HAVE TIME OFF WORK TO VOTE:** You have a right to take time off work to vote without losing your pay, personal leave, or vacation time.
- **VOTE IF IN LINE BY 8 PM:** You have the right to vote if you are in line to vote anytime before 8 p.m.
- **REGISTER ON ELECTION DAY:** You have the right to register to vote on Election Day if you can show the required proof of residence.
- **SIGN IN ORALLY:** You have the right to orally confirm who you are and to ask another person to sign for you if you cannot sign your name.
- **ASK FOR HELP:** You have the right to ask anyone for help, except for an agent of your employer or union.
- **BRING CHILDREN TO THE POLLS:** You have the right to bring your children with you to vote.
- **VOTE AFTER SERVING FELONY CONVICTION:** You can vote after you finish all parts of your sentence, including any probation, parole, or supervised release.
- **VOTE IF UNDER GUARDIANSHIP:** You have the right to vote if you are under a guardianship, unless a judge has revoked your right to vote.
- **VOTE WITHOUT BEING INFLUENCED:** You have the right to vote without anyone in the polling place trying to influence your vote.
- **GET A REPLACEMENT BALLOT:** You have the right to a replacement ballot if you make a mistake on your ballot before you cast it.
- **FILE A COMPLAINT:** You have the right to file a written complaint at your polling place if you are unhappy with the way an election is being run.
- **BRING A SAMPLE BALLOT:** You have the right to take a sample ballot into the voting booth.
- **BRING THE VOTER'S BILL OF RIGHTS:** You have the right to take a copy of this document into the voting booth.

ELECTION DAY

- Tuesday, November 8.
