### **Preschool For All**

Support affordable and quality preschool for all. [8 CDs, 41 OUs, 91%]

### **Statewide, High Quality Public Schools**

Support all public school students having access to local, quality public education through an equitable funding formula to maintain uniform, high quality public schools throughout the state.[8 CDs, 35 OUs,91%]

### **Civics Education**

Support K-12 education that provides a quality civics education including the history of Minnesotans of all races. [8 CDs, 35 OUs, 86%]

### **Affordable Public Education**

Support the basic premise that a fundamental requisite for a thriving democracy, economy and healthy, fulfilling society is a public education system from infant daycare through K-12, vocational, college, and higher education that is robust and affordable. [8 CDs, 18 OUs, 89%]

### **End Privatization of Public Institutions**

Support ending the practice of privatization of public institutions and services, including prisons, hospitals, and educational institutions, and also including other services formerly conducted by public governmental agencies and civil servants. [ 6 CDs, 10 OUs, 81%]

### **Fully Fund School Meals**

Support full funding for all nutrition programs at public schools including, but not limited to healthy food at breakfast, lunch, and snack time. [5 CDs, 9 OUs, 94%]

### **Special Education**

Support encouraging the Minnesota Legislature to more fully fund special education in our state for the purposes of equalizing services for learners and stabilizing the financial positions of districts around the state. [5 CDs, 7 OUs, 87%]
